

NEW SHELLHARBOUR HOSPITAL

PROJECT UPDATE | OCTOBER 2024



Main works construction is set to begin on the new Shellharbour Hospital, with early works now complete. The project is part of the more than \$780 million new Shellharbour Hospital and Integrated Services Project, funded by the NSW and Australian Governments.

The new hospital will provide more care closer to people's homes, reducing the need to travel out of the area for treatment.

It will include state-of-the-art facilities for emergency and critical care, mental health, medicine and surgery, rehabilitation and ambulatory care in a new location where we will continue to care for the community well into the future.

BESIX Watpac has been awarded the contract to build the new hospital.

The appointment of the builder, following the recent approval of the State Significant Development Application, paves the way for the main construction works to begin shortly by initially establishing the site. Additionally, design finalisation for the new hospital is underway.

Construction of the new hospital is expected to be complete in 2027.

Project Scope

The new Shellharbour Hospital will provide the local community with:

- · An expanded emergency department
- Increased surgical capacity
- Rehabilitation and aged care services
- · Acute medical services
- · Mental health services
- Renal dialysis
- Outpatients care services
- Car parking and improved public transport links

The new hospital is being designed to enable construction of a future rooftop helipad.

The project will create around 800 direct and supporting many more indirect jobs during construction.
